General Information Regarding Application for 2018-2019 and Open House

The mission of Notre Dame School is to encourage students to know, live, and develop their Catholic faith. We aim to build a strong academic foundation and help students grow into confident, socially responsible citizens. We will soon be looking to fill our classes for the 2018-2019 school year which begins August 15, 2018. Notre Dame School is a TK - 8th Grade school. TK is Transitional Kindergarten. Students must be age four by September 1, 2018 to be considered for TK. This program expands the Kindergarten program to two years. It is not a substitute for preschool. Students must be age five by September 1, 2018 to be considered for Kindergarten. Priority is given to siblings and families active in the parish. The dates below are for all applicants as specified.

January 16, 2018 - Applications for all grades available online (www.notredamevacaville.org). The first group of applications for TK and K will close on February 16, 2018.

January 28, 2018 - **Open House** for all grades, 1:30 - 2:30 pm.

February 16, 2018 - Group I applications closes for TK and K. Assessment will be scheduled for later in February.

February 26 - March 6 - Parent conference with the principal will take place. (TK and K)

March 7 - Parents will be informed of acceptance/non-acceptance. (TK and K)

February 17 - April 12 - Group II applications for TK and K will be open and considered. Assessment and conference will be scheduled.

April 8 - Assessment week for students wishing to enter grades 1-7.
