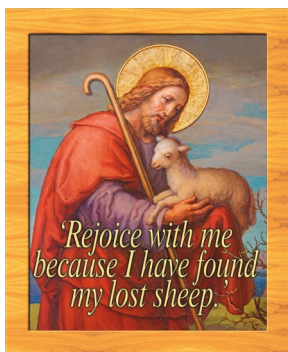

It is recommended to plan ahead if a specific date is desired, as all requirements must be completed at least two weeks prior to the baptism date.

INDEPENDENT COMPENSATION PROGRAM

This Monday afternoon, September 16, the Independent Compensation Program (ICP) will begin accepting registrations. The Diocese of Sacramento is joining those in Los Angeles, Fresno, Orange, San Bernardino and San Diego in a program that brings compensation and justice to those who were sexually abused as minors by diocesan priests. All claims, regardless of how long ago they may have occurred, will be considered by the program. The ICP is independent, outside the control of any diocese.

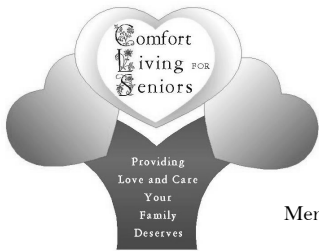
