

#### **REFLECTION FROM FR. JOHN HEALY**

Lord, at this time of Easter, help us to realize that you are alive and active among us. You are present in our work,



you are present in our pain, you are present in our joy. You are present as risen Lord, as one who has overcome defeat, as one who has overcome suffering, as one who has overcome mental anguish and hatred. Lord, you have come through all of these to your glory. Teach me to see you in the difficult times of life; let me realize that it is often in those times that I really grow. I know that as the Apostles awakened that first Easter Sunday they had a deep sense of defeat, of guilt, of confusion, fear and doubt. They felt the great sadness of knowing they had failed to live up to what they were supposed to be. They had betrayed their Master; their lives were shattered and torn. Yet it was in that very moment that you came to them, Lord. You changed their guilt into peace, their defeat into victory, their fear into courage, their doubt

into faith. Their time of crisis, their time of pain, their time of despair, became a time of joy, of hope and of a new beginning. When they were scared by what was worst in them they found what was best—because they knew that you were alive Lord, that you had walked this same road before them and now you were walking with them.

Lord, help me to understand the meaning of resurrection in my life. I have given up, I have become depressed, I have given in to self pity and complaining too often, Lord, when all the time you were there ready to walk with me in my difficulty. You want me to find your risen life, especially in that moment, Lord. Help me to know you are alive, help me to know your kind and understanding voice; help me to feel your healing touch. Amen.
