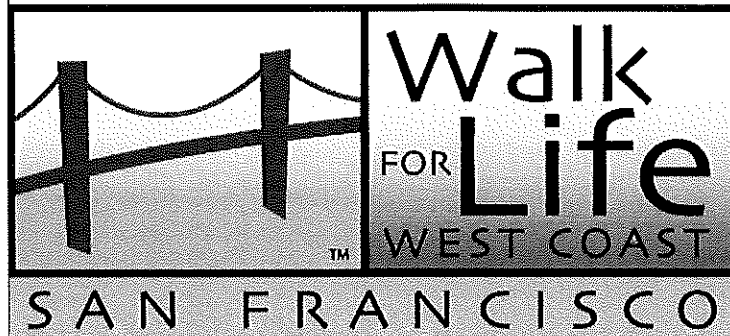

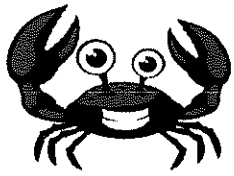
Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament

Bishop Jaime Soto will celebrate this Mass on Sunday, January 22, at 12:10 p.m. at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in downtown Sacramento. Join in this Mass to pray in reparation for the innocent victims of abortion and for the mothers of unborn children. January 22, 2024 marks the anniversary of the lamentable 1973 U.S. Supreme Court decision, Roe v. Wade. While Roe was overturned in 2022, we recognize the tragedy of legalized abortion that still grips the state of California. In the Diocese of Sacramento, Jan. 22 is designated as a Diocesan Day of Reparation. All are asked to participate through fasting, prayer, penance and works of mercy.
